# 1. Obtain a Free Ouote -

Knowing the number of balusters on your stairs and having digital photos are a big help.

#### 2. Product Selection -

Visit www.trinitystairs.com to pick out a baluster pattern. Or you can work with our designers.

#### 3. Preparation -

While we try to limit the amount of dust produced, there will be some. Covering furniture in the area of your stair would be recommended.

## 4. Tear Out -

Old balusters are cut and removed from your stair.

## 5. Installation -

New Balusters are cut to length and epoxied into existing holes.

## 6. Clean Up -

We will remove all of the old balusters and vacuum the stairs to remove any wood chips and debris.
